On Palm Sunday, Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey knowing what would happen to him in that city just a few days later. He knew he would be crucified, but this is what he had been born to do.

Was Jesus ever tempted to abort his earthly mission?

We could consider Jesus praying in the Garden of Gethsemane, just minutes before his arrest. He prays to the Father, “Remove this cup [i.e., the cross] from me” (Mark 14:36). He acknowledges that he’s dreading what’s to come. But in the end he says, “Yet not what I will, but what you will” (v. 36).

It would have been easier for Jesus to have avoided Jerusalem. Instead, he courageously went straight into that city on Palm Sunday. And just five days later, he “*endured* the cross” (Heb. 12:2).

Jesus didn’t give up. He endured. He persevered. For us.
