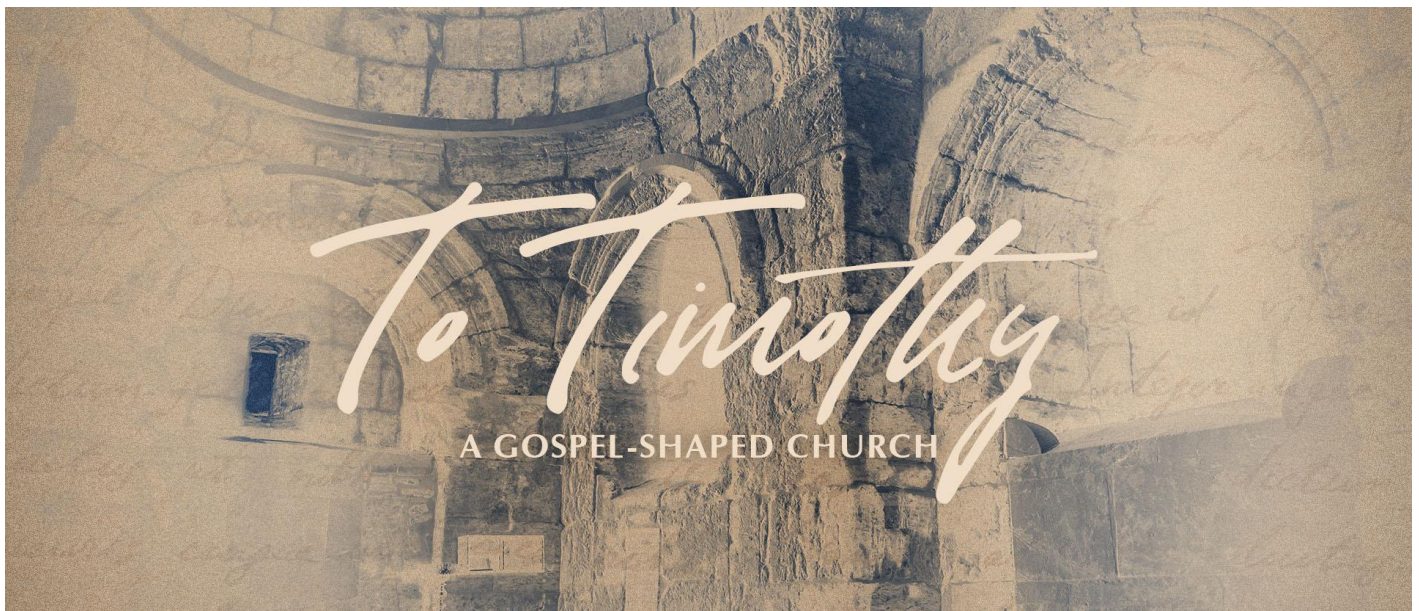

A Person of God



This Sunday, Pastor Jonathan will be sharing part 14 of A Gospel-Shaped Church, a series on the book of 1 Timothy.

As we've been going through 1 Timothy, it's been emphasized that what we *believe* about God and the gospel should affect our *behaviour*.

An important word in 1 Timothy is "godliness" (2:2, 10; 3:16; 4:7, 8; 5:4; 6:3, 5, 6, 11), which could be defined as a lifestyle based on a *right* understanding of God and the gospel.

Therefore, it's essential that we are not deceived by false teaching.

Before our Worship Service, you are encouraged to read 1 Timothy 6:11-21. Take note of verse 11: Paul calls Timothy a "man of God." The Greek word translated "man" (*anthropos*) means "a human being." So Paul is talking about something we all can be: a *person* of God.

What is a *person of God* according to this passage? Think about that question as you prepare your heart for worship.

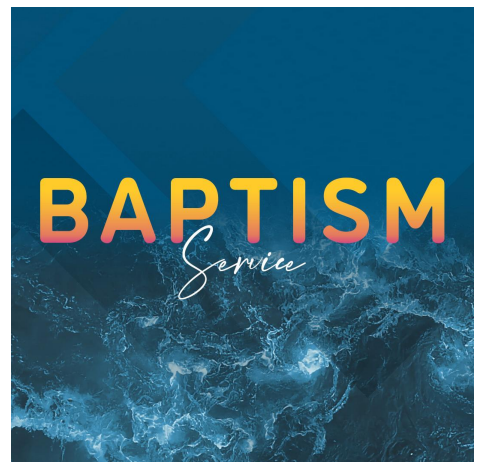
Sunday Morning Worship: If you plan to attend, please fill out our [Attendance Confirmation Form](#). We will also be streaming the service on our [Facebook page](#).

Question	Answer	Scripture
10. What does God require in the fourth and fifth commandments?	Fourth, that on the Sabbath day we spend time in public and private worship of God, rest from routine employment, serve the Lord and others, and so anticipate the eternal Sabbath. Fifth, that we love and honor our father and our mother, submitting to their godly discipline and direction.	Leviticus 19:3 Every one of you shall revere his mother and his father, and you shall keep my Sabbaths: I am the Lord your God.

<p>11. What does God require in the sixth, seventh, and eighth commandments?</p>	<p>Sixth, that we do not hurt, or hate, or be hostile to our neighbor, but be patient and peaceful, pursuing even our enemies with love. Seventh, that we abstain from sexual immorality and live purely and faithfully, whether in marriage or in single life, avoiding all impure actions, looks, words, thoughts, or desires, and whatever might lead to them. Eighth, that we do not take without permission that which belongs to someone else, nor withhold any good from someone we might benefit.</p>	<p>Romans 13:9 For the commandments, “You shall not commit adultery, You shall not murder, You shall not steal, You shall not covet,” and any other commandment, are summed up in this word: “You shall love your neighbor as yourself.”</p>
