When Affliction Comes



This Sunday, we're back in 2 Corinthians! In 1:8-11, the apostle Paul continues to talk about affliction. He goes from talking about affliction in general to a specific occasion of affliction in his own life ("the affliction we experienced in Asia," v. 8).

Affliction is an *outward* circumstance that causes *inward* distress. Paul's affliction affected him emotionally: "We were so utterly burdened beyond our strength that we despaired of life itself" (v. 8).

Affliction will come to us in one form or another. Perhaps you're experiencing affliction at this very moment. *What should we do when affliction comes?*

Please join us this Sunday, whether in person or online, as we tackle this important question about affliction in our lives.
