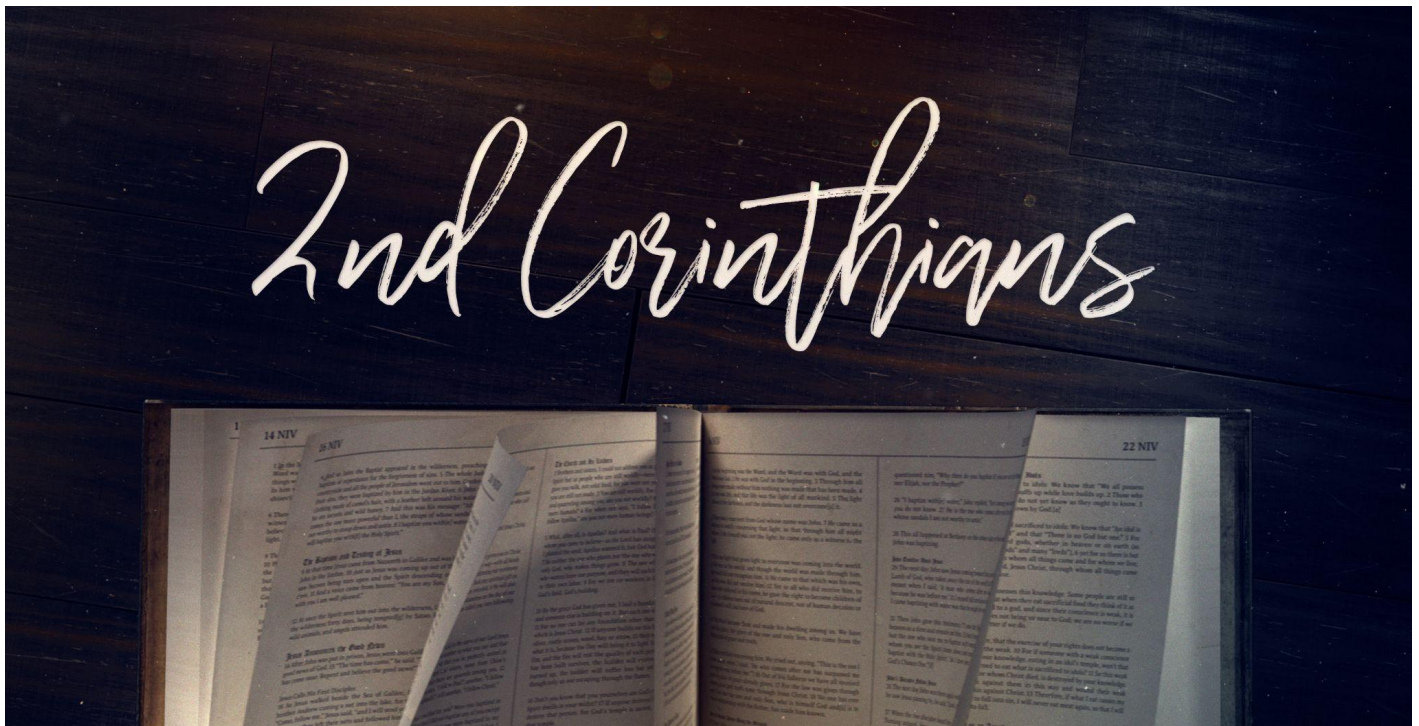

This Sunday, Pastor Jonathan will be starting a new sermon series on 2 Corinthians.

Second Corinthians is Paul's most personal letter. In it, he talks about changing travel plans (1:12-2:4), brings up issues some of the Corinthians had with him (10:1, 10), and shares his struggles in life and ministry (1:8).

You might be wondering: how is all this relevant for us today? We don't live in first-century Corinth; we live in twenty-first century Halifax.

As we begin this series, we'll tackle this and other issues arising from Paul's second letter to the Corinthians.

Please plan to join us this Sunday at 11:00 a.m., whether in person or online. You're also encouraged to start reading through 2 Corinthians.
