

Family Responsibilities



This Sunday, Pastor Jonathan will be sharing part 11 of A Gospel-Shaped Church, a series on the book of 1 Timothy.

The apostle Paul tells Timothy, "Do not rebuke an older man but encourage him *as you would a father*, younger men *as brothers*, older women *as mothers*, younger women *as sisters*, in all purity" (1 Tim. 5:1-2). Back in 3:15, Paul calls the church "the household of God." We are to treat one another as members of the same family.

Verses 3-16 talk about a specific group of people within the church: widows. A church is to view its widows "as mothers," which means we have a responsibility to care for them. Verse 3 says, "Honor widows." Paul was probably thinking of the Fifth Commandment: "Honor your father and your mother" (Exod. 20:12).

We have a responsibility to care for those in our own household and in the household of God.

Before our Worship Service, read 1 Timothy 4:1-16. Take note of what verses 4, 8, and 16 say about the person who doesn't care for a widow in their own family.


Nominating Committee Report: The Nominating Committee report can be found below in this week's newsletter. It has also been posted on the church bulletin board.
