

## Bringing Glory to God's Name



This Sunday, Pastor Jonathan will be sharing part 12 of A Gospel-Shaped Church, a series on the book of 1 Timothy.

In 6:1, the apostle Paul tells Timothy that he doesn't want "the name of God" to be "reviled."

To be "reviled" means to be insulted. God's "name" is his reputation. It's possible for us to act in such a way that we cause God's reputation to be damaged.

No Christian wants God's name to be reviled. We don't want people to say, "Look at those people who call themselves Christians. They talk about following Jesus, but they don't act like him."

Instead, we want to bring glory to God's name, to cause God's reputation to be lifted up, not brought down.

Before our Worship Service, read 1 Timothy 4:17-6:2. Think about the question: *How can we bring glory to God's name?*


## Announcements

## Missionary Update

Below is an update from the Millers:

*This morning we received an email from the Pakistani consulate saying our visas had been refused. No explanation or further information was given and it is unlikely we will be given a reason.*

*We've communicated with the Indus Christian Fellowship (our agency's partner ministry in Pakistan) about the visa refusal and are in touch about whether there is anything further that can be done following the refusal. We are currently processing the grief of this and are also in conversation with our sending agency, Fellowship International, about options and opportunities.*

*For now we ask you to pray with us as we consider what our next steps are. As we've received this news we feel like God has been preparing us for this. We've been considering what our vision is for*



ministry and have felt God directing us to Matthew 28:16-20 over and over again. He has reminded us that his vision for all of us is to make disciples of all nations wherever we go and whatever we do. That call remains the same whether we go to Pakistan or not. That's been a constant message for us lately so while this visa refusal from Pakistan is disappointing, we are prayerfully considering what God has for us.

All of that said it's safe to say we're in a period of grieving. It's been a five year journey for us since Kevin left engineering in 2016 to pursue ministry. Obviously, this visa refusal was not what we were wanting or expecting. We are trusting God that the time we've spent so far is not in vain, but right now, it still hurts.

Thank you for walking in this journey with us, thank you for supporting us in your prayers, thank you for being our friends, family, encouragers and partners.
