

## The Source of Godliness Is Not a Mystery



This Sunday, Pastor Jonathan will be sharing part 7 of *A Gospel-Shaped Church*, a series on the book of 1 Timothy.

In 1 Timothy 3:14-15, the apostle Paul gives Timothy the reason for what he's written in chapters 2 and 3: "so that . . . you [and the church in Ephesus] may know *how one ought to behave in the household of God.*"

A word that Paul often uses for this type of behavior is "godliness." For example, Paul tells Timothy, "Train yourself for *godliness*; for while bodily training is of some value, *godliness* is of value in every way, as it holds promise from the present life and also for the life to come" (1 Tim. 4:7-8). How many of us have that backwards, thinking more about our physical health than our godliness?

This Sunday, we are going to consider three questions. First, *what is godliness?* Second, *what is the source of godliness?* And, third, *why is godliness so important?* Before the livestream, you are encouraged to read 1 Timothy 3:14-16, and think about these three questions.
