This Friday and Saturday, our church is hosting Fellowship Atlantic's Regional Conference!

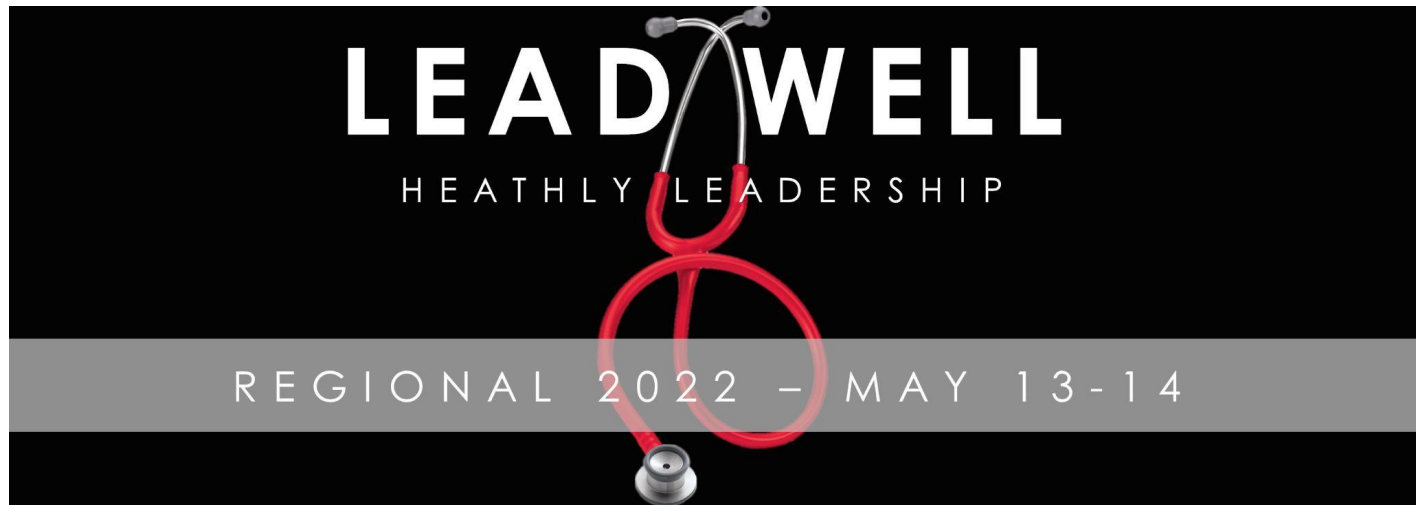
The key verse for this year's conference is 3 John 1:2, which says, "Beloved, I pray that all may go well with you and that you may be in good health, as it goes well with your soul."
