

Entrusted with the Gospel



This Sunday, we're beginning a new series of sermons on the book of 1 Timothy. The series is called *A Gospel-Shaped Church*.

First Timothy was written by the apostle Paul to a young man named Timothy, whom Paul had put in charge of the church in Ephesus. Throughout this letter, Paul urges Timothy to defend the truth of the gospel against false teaching. For example, Paul writes, "O Timothy, guard the deposit [i.e., the gospel] entrusted to you" (6:20).

In its introduction to 1 Timothy, the *ESV Study Bible* says the following:

The theme of 1 Timothy is that the gospel leads to practical, visible change in the lives of those who believe it. It is often thought that the theme is church order, but the discussion of church offices is simply a piece of the larger argument that the true gospel, in contrast to false teaching, will always lead to godliness in its adherents.
