

Men and Women in the Church



This Sunday, Pastor Jonathan will be sharing part 5 of *A Gospel-Shaped Church*, a series on the book of 1 Timothy.

Preaching through a book of the Bible forces you to address some passages that you might otherwise avoid. We have now come to such a passage: 1 Timothy 2:8-15, a difficult and controversial section of Scripture. The passage is about men and women in the church, but it's mostly about women.

Here are a few clarifying comments on this passage:

- In this passage, Paul is talking about the public worship of the church. He's not saying anything about a woman teaching or exercising authority outside that setting.
- When Paul writes that a woman is to "remain quiet," he doesn't mean that a woman can't speak during public worship.
- When Paul says that "the woman [i.e., Eve] was deceived," he's not saying that women are more easily deceived than men.

Prior to this Sunday's livestream, read 1 Timothy 2:8-15. Is there anything in this passage that you struggle to understand or accept?


Sunday Worship

This Sunday is Trinity Sunday. The Athanasian Creed says,

We worship one God in trinity and the trinity in unity, neither blending their persons nor dividing their essence. For the person of the Father is a distinct person, the person of the Son is another, and that of the Holy Spirit is still another. But the divinity of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is one, their glory equal, their majesty coeternal.

Simply put, our God is triune: one God who is three equal, yet distinct, persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Nothing happens except through him and by his will.	Psalm 86:8-10, 15 There is none like you among the gods, O Lord, nor are there any works like yours. All the nations you have made shall come and worship before you, O Lord, and shall glorify your name. For you are great and do wondrous things; you alone are God But you, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness.
