This Sunday, Pastor Jonathan will be sharing the final part of the series *Don't Give Up*.

Paul's ministry as an apostle of Jesus Christ was incredibly difficult, but he never raised the white flag. He never gave up.

The question we're asking in this series is *Why should we not give up in ministry?* Ministry isn't limited to people like Paul. It isn't limited to pastors and missionaries. *Every* believer has been called by God into ministry. He expects *all of us* to serve others.

Second Corinthians 6:3-13, especially verses 11-13, could be summed up with the following statement: **Ministry is a labour of love.** According to Merriam-Webster.com, a "labour of love" is "a labour voluntarily undertaken or performed without consideration of any benefit or reward."

Like ministry, being a mom is a labour of love. The motivation for a mom is not what she can gain from her children. The motivation is love for her children. This is the kind of attitude we should all have toward ministry.

We hope you will join us this Sunday. To prepare for the sermon, you could read 2 Corinthians 6:3-13.

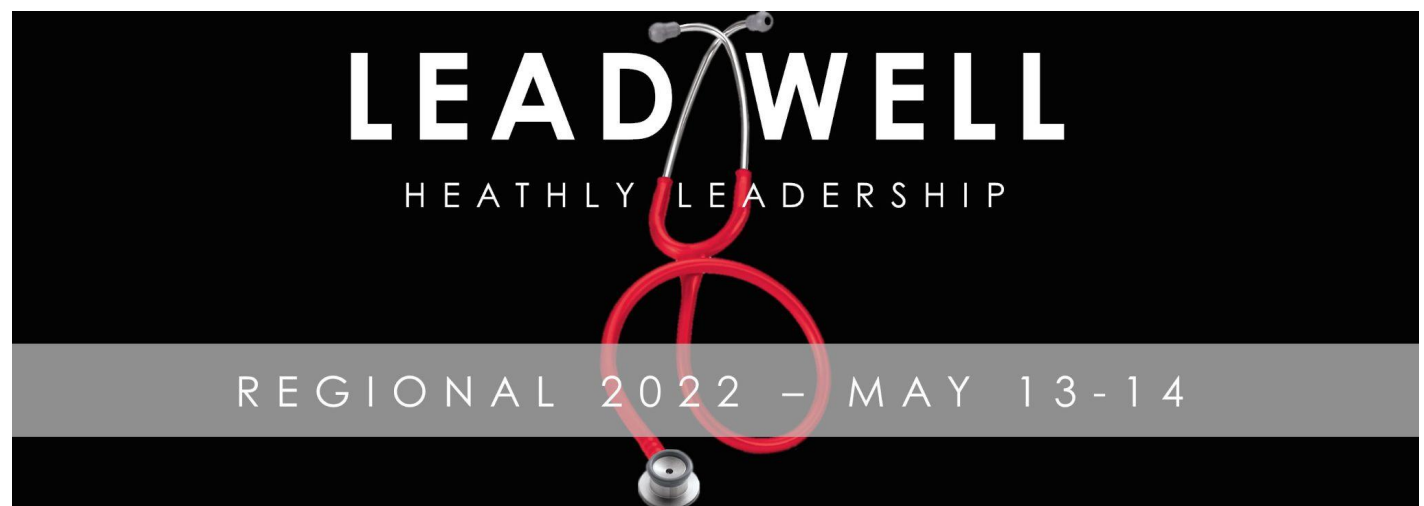
